

A leader in theatre and theatre arts education in the State of Alabama since 1961, Fantasy Playhouse Children's Theater & Academy (FPCTA) is a 501 (c) non-profit bringing the magic of theatre to more than 31,000 residents annually, including 21,000 children and youth. FPCTA provides theatre arts access through production, education, and outreach while enriching the lives of children and families through theatre programming that encourages students to become self confident, academically successful, creative-thinking citizens who are more likely to invest in their communities as adults. FPCTA is known across the southeast for excellence in live children's theatre productions, classes, camps, workshops, fine arts preschool and education outreach through after school theatre programs and In-School Touring Programs.

FPCTA prioritizes theatre arts access for all. Recognizing the transformative power theatre arts can have in the life of a child, their family, and their community.

SPECIAL STAGES

Special stages make space for audiences with special access needs. During Sensory Friendly Performances, visual and sound effects are lowered, fidget toys and other sensory assistance tools are distributed, and house lights are dimly lit to accommodate first time patrons with sensory disabilities. American Sign Language performances are offered regularly to support our deaf and hard of hearing audiences.

These performances are part of FPCTA's commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion, one of the first initiatives of its kind to take place in Alabama. Each mainstage title will include a special stage production for differently abled audiences.



ACADEMY SPONSORSHIPS

FPCTA reaches thousands of students through classes, workshops, camps, after-school partnerships, and in-school touring programs every year. We offer a full spectrum of theatre arts training, ranging from preschool creative dramatic programs to advanced performing arts skills and technical theatre.

Students ages 3-Adult will Discover their Shine, through teamwork, learning acting skills, and mastering the self-confidence they need to step into the center stage of their lives.

★ Student Matinee Series Sponsor

FPCTA is a gateway to a lifelong love of theatre and offers reduced-priced student matinee performances for up to 2,400 students annually. Productions feature a study guide developed specifically to support AL Learning Standards and curriculum activities for teachers to incorporate into their classrooms before and after the show.

FPCTA believes that no child should be denied access to quality theatre arts programming and education. Technical Theatre offers students a creative way of approaching STEM learning, using subjects like lighting design, set construction, film animation, special effects, and sound engineering as a way to introduce and engage creative students in highly sought after technological career fields


